



SOLD – 12g round action by John Dickson & Son – 29" x 2 1/2" barrels

Description

SOLD – This is the round action I had advertised last year which was built in 1920 to match gun number 6464. It was originally built with a 1 1/2" cast off, but I decided to reduce the cast to 1/4", which incidentally makes the gun look left handed. However, it shoulders beautifully and for the person who can see past the awkwardness of the stock, they would be buying an original Dickson, with its original woodwork and barrels, at about half price of a conventionally stocked gun. Stock length is 14 3/4" and restoration work I've carried out on the woodwork has been, I think, the making of this gun. The 29" x 2 1/2" chopperlump barrels are blemish free and the lock work is gilded. Engraving style on the action and locks is bold acanthus and the signature John Dickson and Son patent is engraved within a cartouche. The gun has had a full mechanical overhaul, barrels blacked, furniture blacked and safe re-chequered and blued. I think it represents excellent value and will make a superb reliable game gun for someone.
