

20g Sidelock Ejector by E.J. Churchill – 26 1/2 x 2 3/4? barrels

Description

This is a 20g sidelock ejector E.J. Churchill with 26 1/2? x 2 3/4? chopper lump barrels with a raise Churchill cross-filed rib, and has an ivory bead. It's an Imperial Medel suilt circa late 40's/ early 50's. The gun is engraved with acanthus scroll and retains over 50 %. This original hardening colour and is fitted with a 14 1/2? stock. It has a rolled edged triangly chard, a pierced skeleton heel plate and has Churchill's single trigger system, which was shaddifully. It was originally purchased by a man in Tokyo and some 70 years later has a tupled back into the UK. It comes in it's maker case and with a slight reduction to the chokes 165 gun will be capable of firing standard steel cartridges. What a beauty.
