



Pair of 12g A&D ejectors by Harrison & Hussey 28 x 2 1/2? barrels

Description

This beautiful pair of Harrison & Hussey A&D Ejector guns was built circa 1925. Engraving on the actions, cover plates, etc. is fine scroll and 'Harrison & Hussey Ltd.' is engraved on the side of the actions and the cover plates in an arched banner. The original 28 x 2 1/2? barrels have concave top ribs with number 1 & 2 inlaid in gold at the breech ends. On the top levers and fore-end tips and the guns have full spindle lever systems, rocker safes and Southgate ejectors. Beautifully figured, one-piece stocks measuring 14 1/2 have panels and drop points and the fore-ends are also fitted with case-hardened fore-end diamonds and fine fore-end tips. The guns have just been stripped, cleaned and have had a full re-joint. What a beautiful pair of guns all ready for the coming season.
