



SOLD – 12g, round action by John Dickson & Son – 28? x 2 1/2? barrels

### Description

SOLD – This round action was built in 1925 and has 28? x 2 1/2? chopperlump steel barrels. Built as a single gun, the action and lock plate are engraved with fine rose and scroll. The barrels have been re-proved at 740 and both tubes now measure 741. Both walls are down to 18 thou with a couple of small pit marks. Re-stocked at some point, this gun was fitted with a leather covered recoil pad to a finished length of 14 5/8?. The gun opens and closes beautifully, fires and ejects and comes in its lightweight maker's case with trade label. Dickson lightweights tended to weigh from 5lbs 14oz to 6lb 4oz, resulting in generally not very thick barrel walls. If you can see past the 18 thou walls, I think this gun represents good value and will make a reliable gun for its next owner. I will happily sell this with a 2 year mechanical warranty.
