



12g sidelock ejector by Charles Hellis & Sons – 28? x 2 1/2? barrels

Description

This beautiful Charles Hellis sidelock was built circa 1910 and has 28? x 2 1/2? steel barrels, which are engraved with “Charles Hellis & Sons, 119 Edgeware Road, Hyde Park, London W”. It’s fully engraved with fine scroll and scrolled borders with a vignette of a rose on the underside of the action body. The gun is No. 2 of a pair and retains about 50% of its original hardening colour. The 14 3/4? stock is beautifully figured with a Silver’s pad and has a beautiful gold escutcheon plate. What a beautiful gun which will be capable of firing standard steel cartridges without alteration. It comes in a brassbound leather case.

Disclaimer: to be clear this gun is suitable to fire standard steel cartridges but is not proved for steel.
