

SOLD – 12g single trigger, sidelock ejector by William Powell & Son – 26? x 2 1/2? chopperlump barrels

Description

SOLD – This is a truly beautiful gun, built in 1927 with 26? x 2 1/22 two pperlump barrels, choked improved cylinder and 3/8. Engraving style on the action and two is Powell's best rose and scroll along with olive leaf fences, and the top rib reads "WHRAL Powell & Son, 35 Carrs Lane, Birmingham". It has a non-selective single trigger system, which beliects very positively, and the gun has a beautifully figured 14 1/4? stock including a Silveris use and a half-inch spacer. Retaining about 25% of its original hardening colour, the 1/2 is fitted with Southgate ejectors and is presented in a William Powell case full of accessories. It is described in the records as "best quality with extra finish". I think this is probably the most attractive William Powell I have seen.
