



Pair of 12g A&D Ejectors by William Evans 28 x 2 1/2" barrels

Description

This beautiful pair of William Evans box lock ejectors was built circa 1905. They have 28" x 2 1/2" steel barrels and the top rib reads "William Evans (from Purdey's) 61, Pall Mall, St James's, London". The guns are numbered 1 & 2 in gold on the top levers, barrel breech ends and fore-end irons. The actions are signed "William Evans" and are engraved with the scroll. They are fitted with intercepting sears, Southgate ejectors and a spindle lever system. The guns have 14 3/8" highly figured one piece stocks with panels and drop points. All in all original guns that come in their maker's case with accessories. The guns have been restored to very high level; somebody spent a lot of money on them.
