



Pair of 12g sidelock ejectors by James Purdey & Sons – 28? x 2 3/4? barrels

Description

This pair of Purdeys was built circa 1885, are assisted opening and have Purdey's fine rose and scroll engraving. Both pairs of barrels have been sleeved to 28? with 2 3/4? chambers and, unusually, have a third locking grip to the barrels. The number 1 gun is choked 3/4 and full and the no 2 gun 1/4 ad 3/4. Stock lengths are 14 1/2?, which includes a leather covered recoil pad and the no 1 gun has a replacement stock. A super old pair of vintage guns presented in their makers' case with trade label.
